

Monmouth BaconFest – Bacon Eating Challenge/Contest Waiver

I, the undersigned, hereby warrant a representant that I am 18 years of age or older and I have valid photo identification to prove my age which I will furnish upon demand to the organizers of the BaconFest Bacon Eating Challenge (“Contest”). I agree to abide by all contest rules and, if chosen to compete, to compete in a safe and reasonable manner, and to accept all judge’s ruling.

I understand that there are risks of personal injury, illness and possible loss of life or property which may result from participation in an eating contest and in the consumption of large qualities of food and calories over both short and extended periods of time.

If chosen to participate, I certify that I am entering into the Contest of my own free will and I assume sole liability for all risks. I certify that I am in good health and have consulted with qualified person in the medical treatment or care that may be available. I expressly understand that entry and participation in the contest and all related events and activities, including, without limitation, travel to the contest and time spent in and around the area of the contest interview with and potential negative portrayals by the media is at my own risk and I assume sole liability for all such risks.

I agree to cooperate and speak with media and interviews authorized by the contest organizers regarding the contest. If chosen to participate, I hereby give and grant to the contest parties (as defined below) and their respective owners, parents, subsidiaries, division, partners, representatives, agents, licensees, successors and assigns (collectively, the “Tourism Committee” of the Monmouth Area Chamber of Commerce) and unconditional, non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free, irrevocable license and right to use my name, image, biographical information, performance, voice, photograph, interviews and likeness (collectively “image rights”) in connection with the contest in all media and content whether now existing or later discovered or invented for any and all types of advertising, publicity, marketing, promotion, exhibition and other purpose that is connected to the contest parties. I also hereby waive, on behalf of myself, successors, heirs and assigns and anyone else claiming under me or on my behalf, all ownership or other property rights to my performance in the contest and all related activities in perpetuity in all media whatsoever. I agree that no materials need to be submitted to me for any approval, and the contest parties and license parties shall have no liability to me or anyone else for any distortion, illusionary effect or otherwise resulting from the use of my image rights. Nothing herein will constitute any obligation on the contest parties or license parties to make use of the image rights.

I, on behalf of myself, my successors, heirs and assigns and anyone else claiming under me, hereby completely, irrevocably and unconditionally release and hold harmless all sponsors and licensees of the Monmouth BaconFest – Bacon Eating Challenge; organizers of the contest; the venue holding the contest; respective owners, directors, officers, agents, attorneys, employees, fiduciaries, parents, subsidiaries, division, partners, sponsors, licensees, joint ventures, affiliated business entities, predecessors, successors, heirs, and assigns (collectively, the “Contest Parties”), jointly and severally, from any and all claims, liabilities, damages, losses, expenses, suits, discrimination or other charges, demands, debts, liens, damages, costs, attorneys’ fees, pre-judgement or other interest, grievances, injuries, actions or rights of action of any nature whatsoever now or in the future arising in any way out of or in connection with the Bacon Eating Challenge (Contest).

I understand that, to be eligible to compete to compete in the contest and receive appearance fees, prizes and/or prize money, I must respect social norms for acceptable behavior during and surrounding my participation in the contest, and I must obey the laws, rules and regulations of the cities, states, and countries in which the contest is held. I agree not to defame or damage through my actions or omissions the contest parties or license parties. If I fail to adhere to this code of conduct and/or fail to participate in an ethical manner, then I cede all right to receive any prizes and/or to compete in future events held by the Contest Parties, in their discretion.

I fully acknowledge and understand that I do not have any right to participate in this contest and related activities and that the decision as to whether or not I am permitted to participated is in the Contest Parties’ sole discretion and is in consideration of my execution of this document. If it were not for my agreement to execute this document, I acknowledge that I would not be permitted to participate. I further acknowledge an degree that I understand all of the terms and conditions of this document. I also understand that I will be given a signed copy of this document if I so request.

Entry information

- Eaters must fill out and sign a contest release waiver.

Eating contest process/Rules

- The BaconFest eating contest is limited to eight contestants who will be selected from all of the entries in the sole and exclusive discretion of BaconFest Committee. The total amount participating may change on the discretion of the BaconFest Committee.
- Eaters will be allowed to drink water as needed while competing.
- Eaters will receive a pre-weighted plate.
- Vomiting will result in disqualification from the contest.
- Eaters must remain seated upon conclusion until judges release you.
- Contestants will not be allowed to wear headphones.
- The eater who finishes his or her plate first will be declared the winner. The Winner will be declared by the appointed judge. The judges will have absolute and final authority in determining the contest winner.
- In the event of a tie, a one-minute eat-off will be held.
- The winner will be announced directly following the eating contest on stage.
- Contestants will be asked to remain in the contest area for photo opportunities prior to release.

Prizes

- The winner of the Bacon Eating Contest will be awarded a booklet worth one free year of bacon.
